

Job Title: Worship Pastor Position Status: Full-Time (minimum of 40 hours per week)

Position Summary:

The Worship Pastor will work collaboratively with church leadership to align the worship ministry with the church's vision and mission.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan, prepare, and lead engaging worship services that glorify God and encourage congregational participation.
- Select appropriate worship songs and arrangements that align with the message and church vision.

- Maintain copyright and licensing compliance for music and media use (e.g., CCLI).
- Ensure all worship-related equipment is maintained and in good working order.

6. Special Services and Events

- Plan and lead worship for special services such as holidays, weddings, funerals, and church events.
- Collaborate with other ministries (e.g., youth, children, outreach) to integrate worship into their programs as needed.
