

Job Title: Music Director (Choir-Led Service)
Position Status: Part-time (8-10 hours per week)

Position Summary:

The Music Director provides musical leadership for the church's choir-led worship services, primarily through directing the adult choir and selecting music that enhances worship and reflects the church's mission. This position focuses on cultivating Christ-centered, meaningful worship through traditional music and choral leadership.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Worship Music Planning & Leadership

- Select hymns, choral anthems, and service music in coordination with the Worship Pastor.
- Lead the choir in weekly rehearsals and direct during Sunday morning choir-led worship services.

- Manage the church's Planning Center account for the choir-led service, inputting song selections, scheduling volunteers, uploading resources, and updating service plans.
- Communicate regularly with staff and choir members regarding schedules and music selections.

- A strong and growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Commitment to the mission and theological values of the church.
- Demonstrated skill in choral conducting and vocal training.
- Ability to read music and arrange parts as needed.
- Familiarity with traditional church music and hymnody.
